Policy Motions Passed in Original Form

- **2025 Policy Motion #21: Amend *Sponsor Guidelines/4th Step Inventory Steps 4 and 5* (p. 6) to bring wording into alignment with the Seven Tools** – in the sentence “Sponsors who have a slip must notify their sponsor and all sponsees, answer questions as assigned by their sponsor for 30 days and help the sponsee find another sponsor if the sponsee wishes to change,” remove the phrase “if the sponsee wishes to change”; submitted by Diane S., endorsed by Electronic Intergroup English

Policy Motions that Failed

- **Policy Motion #1: Create a WSBC Ad Hoc Committee to study holding the CEA HOW Convention/ World Service Business Conference biannually, and virtually when not in person.**, submitted by Paul M., endorsed by Area 3,4,5
- **Policy Motion #2: Modify the CEA-HOW Service Manual (Item #858)**, adding the Twelve Concepts of Service, special event and workshop guidelines and descriptions of Phone Bridge English service positions; submitted by the Board Literature Committee in conjunction with the Conference Literature Committee

Bylaws Amendment Passed in Original Form

- **Bylaws Amendment #1: Distribution of excess Intergroup funds; amend Article 20 Intergroups, Section 4 Operation:** distribute excess revenue beyond prudent reserve and planned events for the upcoming year – 60% to World Service Office, 40% to Area; submitted by Board Bylaws Committee
